

2021 Rebild Keynote Speaker Releases New Book

Anders Agner Pedersen, Editor-in-Chief of [Kongressen.com](#) has just released a new book about the Kennedy family political history. The book will be arriving in Danish book stores this week and is currently available in Danish. Pedersen was one of the keynote speakers at the 2021 Rebild Festival, July 4th in Denmark. He is author of more than ten much acclaimed books on American politics and history. He is known to be one of Denmark's most competent USA analysts, especially as a regular commentator on the Danish TV channel, DR. His podcast series, KENNEDYLAND, is also a great success. At Rebild, Pedersen spoke about former JFK White House Counsel, Danish American [Ted Sorensen](#). Pedersen's keynote, included in the July 4 Rebild festival [can be seen here](#).

Pedersen said, "***For more than a decade, I've been covering the Kennedy family as an author. I've done a couple of books about President Kennedy and about his brother, Bobby. However, I always wanted to write the complete history of the dynasty, from its founding 100 years ago and to present time. It's been an incredible experience writing the book and I sure hope that people are going to enjoy it.***"

Chapter-East is my home chapter, so there I am part of the ongoing dialogue, but many of the things I brought back with me from Mid-Vest were new to me, I want to thank you for your positive input, and I really appreciate the written followup I have received from Jørgen Jeppesen, I am definitely going to use the input in coming discussions and plans.

My feeling is that there is a lot of positive ideas and thinking in the organisation, but it is important that the ideas reach the board, so please start sharing them with us, please use Bruce's and my email, we promise to listen and take the ideas seriously and make sure they reach the board. It is the responsibility of the board to have a strategy for the future and we do, and the responsibility of the General Secretary to effectuate the boards plans. 2021 Rebild hovedtaler udgiver ny bog

Anders Auger Pedersen, Chefredaktør for [Kongressen.com](#) har lige udgivet en ny bog om Kennedy familiens politiske historie. Bogen vil være at finde hos danske boghandlere i denne uge og er foreløbig kun udkommet på dansk. Pedersen var en af hovedtalerne på 2021 Rebildfesten, den 4. juli i Danmark. Han er forfatter til flere end ti anmelderroste bøger om amerikansk politik og historie. Han er kendt som en af Danmarks mest kompetente USA analytikere, især som kommentator på DR1. Hans podcast serie KENNEDYLAND er blevet en stor succes. Ved Rebild talte Pedersen om dansk-amerikaneren Ted Sorenson, som var ansat i det Hvide Hus som rådgiver for Præsident Kennedy. Pedersen sagde, "Jeg har i mere end et årti interesseret mig for Kennedyfamilien i min egenskab af forfatter. Jeg har skrevet et par bøger om Præsident Kennedy og om hans bror, Bobby. Men, jeg har altid gerne villet skrive hele historien om dynastiet, fra begyndelsen, omkring 100 år siden, til i dag. Det har været en utrolig spændende oplevelse at skrive bogen og jeg håber virkelig, at folk vil nyde at læse den."

Nyt fra Danmark
